

**State Pension Review Board (PRB)**  
Energy Savings Program  
Quarterly Report  
1st Quarter 2015 (January-March)

In accordance with the requirements of Executive Order RP-49, the PRB provides the following update of its energy savings program:

- I. **Resource Efficiency Plan for Facilities** - PRB occupies space in a Texas Facility Commission (TFC) managed facility. The agency does not pay utilities and is therefore unable to measure its energy consumption and report on the effectiveness of its energy savings program. The agency does however continue to follow the guidelines published in its Resource Efficiency Plan, revised September 2014, which includes the following routine practices:
  - A. Train and educate employees on ways to conserve and reduce energy consumption.
  - B. Turn off or avoid unnecessary use of lights and equipment.
  - C. Reduce energy consumption through the requirement of energy saving features on all future equipment purchases.
  - D. Schedule operations to avoid use of state buildings outside of normal M-F working hours.
  - E. Encourage staff to carpool or take public transportation to off-site meetings and agency activities.
  - F. Report energy and water consumption problems to TFC.
- II. **Fleet Fuel Management Plan for Vehicles** – PRB does not operate a fleet of vehicles.

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
