The May 7, 2020 joint meeting of the Investment and Actuarial Committees of the PRB will be held by teleconference call as authorized under Sections 551.125 and 551.127 of the Texas Government Code. THIS MEETING WILL BE CONDUCTED BY TELECONFERENCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GOVERNOR'S AUTHORIZATION OF MARCH 16, 2020, CONCERNING SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN OPEN MEETING LAW REQUIREMENTS IN RESPONSE TO THE DECLARATION OF STATE DISASTER OF MARCH 13, 2020 CONCERNING THE COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) PANDEMIC. A quorum of members of each committee will participate in the meeting and will be audible to the public. Members of the public may provide public comment by registering first with the Office Manager by submitting an email to Lindsay.Seymour@prb.texas.gov identifying the name of the speaker and topic, no later than 8:00 am on May 7, 2020. The presiding officer will call roll of committee members, followed by calling roll of members of the public who have registered. The presiding officer will then ask if other attendees wish to provide comment, at which time each such attendees shall identify themselves by name and topic of the comment. Members of the public who have registered during roll call will be called by name at the appropriate time in the agenda. Attendees are requested to mute their connections when not addressing the committee members.

The Committees may discuss or take action regarding any of the items on this agenda. A quorum of the board may be present during the joint meeting of the Actuarial and Investment committees, which will address the following agenda items.
